Visits With Veterans. Phil Medeiros, Skip Fisher and Sid Rabin

We visited 5 facilities and 2 home since the December meeting.

We met with 21 Veterans and Residents by 19 Post member hours and the ladies from the Sewin4Servicemen group. We have finished the local distribution of Lap Quilt and we are moving on to other areas.
