As of our target date of 50% on September 13th, the Department of CT was ranked 35<sup>th</sup> nationally and 9th in the Northeast Region. On September 22nd we jumped up to 19th nationally and 5th in the Northeast Region. That's a bit more like it! It also puts us a bit ahead of last year at this time and that's what we're looking for. Thanks much for the hard work!

As a Department we met our September goal. Six Districts achieved at least 50% and one district was just a "whisker" short of 50%. As of this writing, we have already reached our October goal of 55% as a Department. Again, Thanks much and keep up the good work. A real test will come on November 15th when our target goal will be 65%. I know team CT can do it! Please keep your eyes on our membership target dates. You know what happens when we achieve our target date goals. We achieve 100% membership!!

We can send a team into any post and help work membership. Posts need only to ask. Otherwise, the District and I may just land up on the doorstep!

That's great work and it's sincerely appreciated! We also have posts well on their way to achieving quota post status and that's great as well. Thanks again!

Begin today to make preparations for the observance by following these suggestions:

- 1) Contact the Post Commander, Adjutant, and (the) 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee Chairman to find out what is being planned by the post for the 50<sup>th</sup> Birthday.
- 2) Become acquainted with ideas and pointers set forth in the special 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Planning Guide...beginning with February 1968 (Advance)...
- 3) Determine what kind of historical information and pictures will be needed by your 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee. Ask the post adjutant for access to official files to locate this material, and either pull it for your use or make note of where you can locate it when ready to use information.

- 5) Compile a roster of your Post's officers, showing years served.
- 6) Compile a roster of the post's charter members.

- 9) Consult your County, District, and Department History on plans for the observance of the Golden Anniversary of The American Legion.

Dear Commander:

In reply to your recent request, The National Organization of The American Legion was granted its exempt status by the Internal Revenue Service in 1934. In February of 1946, we submitted to the central office of the Internal Revenue Service a complete listing of all Departments and Posts extant in the Legion up to and including December 31, 1945. With our submission we requested a group ruling which would extend exemption from the payment of federal income tax for those Departments and Posts designated in our listing.

Each year since 1946 supplemental listings have been transmitted to the Internal Revenue Service for an over-all group ruling covering those Departments and Posts chartered during the previous year. Group rulings have been issued yearly by the Internal Revenue Service covering those Departments and Posts. Your post was included in our original listing. Enclosed is a copy of the original ruling.

Section 101(8) referred to in the exemption letter corresponds to Section 501 (c) (4) of the 1954 Code. The American Legion, its component Departments and Posts were exempt from the payment of federal income tax under this Section up to and including the year 1972. By virtue of the passage of Public Law 92-418 on August 29, 1972, veterans' organizations were given a separate classification under the Code, Section 501(c) (19). A copy of that ruling is also enclosed.

Also enclosed please find a copy of a letter we received from the Internal Revenue Service dated February 17, 1976, wherein the National Organization, Departments and Posts were instructed to use the number 0925 as their Group Exemption Number (GEN) when filing their Form 990.

In addition, the status of The American Legion and its Departments and Posts may allow acceptance of charitable gifts and bequests. The following might be of assistance to you.

Deductibility of Contributions to The American Legion is governed by 26 U.S.C. 170 (c) (3) Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

Deductibility for bequests is established by 26 U.S.C. Section 2055 (a) (4).

Section 170(c) (3) reads as follows:

"Section 170. Charitable, etc., contributions and gifts

(a) Allowance of deduction

(1) General Rule. -There shall be allowed as a deduction any charitable contribution (as defined in sub-section (c) payment of which is made within the taxable year. A charitable contribution shall be allowable as a deduction only if verified under regulations prescribed by the Secretary or his delegate.

\* \* \*

(c) Charitable contribution defined. For purposes of this section the term 'charitable contribution' means a contribution or gift to or for the use of-

(3) A post or organization of war veterans, or an auxiliary unit or society of, or trust or foundation for, any such post or organization

(A) organized in the United States or any of its possessions, and

(B) no part of the net earnings of which inures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual."

### **S**-igns of a person in crisis

- Thinking about, talking about or threatening suicide, or having a specific plan
- Using alcohol or drugs (or using more)
- Anxious, agitated, or talking about revenge, feeling like a burden
- Making preparations for suicide; acquiring means (gun, pills, other)
- Withdrawing from people or activities / isolating, making comments of hopelessness\*

### **A**-sk the question

- Be direct and straightforward
  - "Are you thinking about suicide?"
  - "Have you been thinking about killing yourself?"
  - "Have you made a plan for how you would kill yourself?"

### **V**-alidate

- Do not argue or try to convince person why he/she is wrong
- Do offer support and empathy.

### **E**-ncourage & **E**-xpeditate immediate assessment

- *In person:* Encourage person to speak to mental health provider  
Escort him/her to the emergency room  
Do NOT leave a person in suicidal crisis alone until seen by mental health provider
- *By phone:* Encourage person to go to come into this VAMC's Emergency Department or nearest emergency room  
Make sure Caller is aware of the Veterans Crisis Line **1-800-273-8255 (#1)**
- *Off Station/CBOCs:* Do NOT leave a person in suicidal crisis alone until assessed by MH staff  
Contact Clinic MH staff to discuss  
Call 911 for Veteran(s) in need of ED transport
- *Everyone:* If anyone is in immediate medical or mental health emergency, call **911**

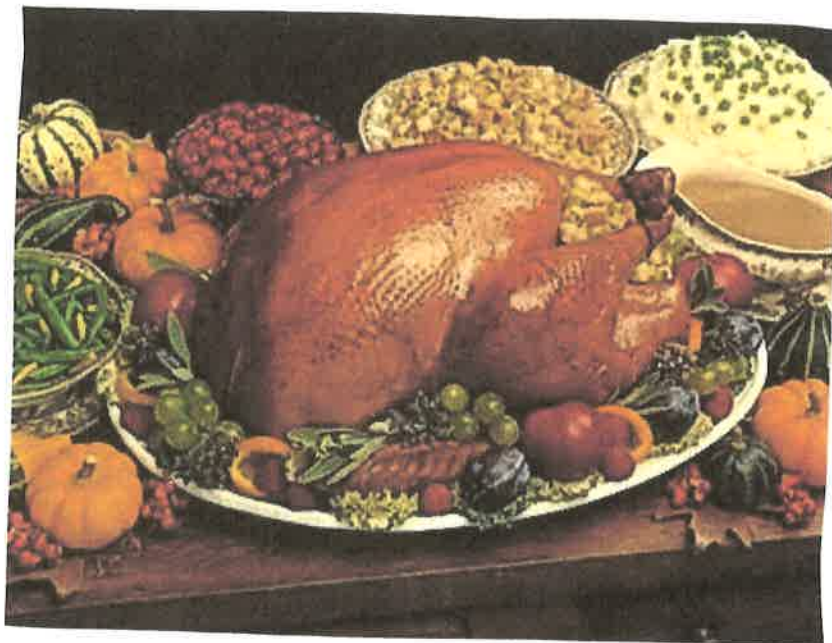

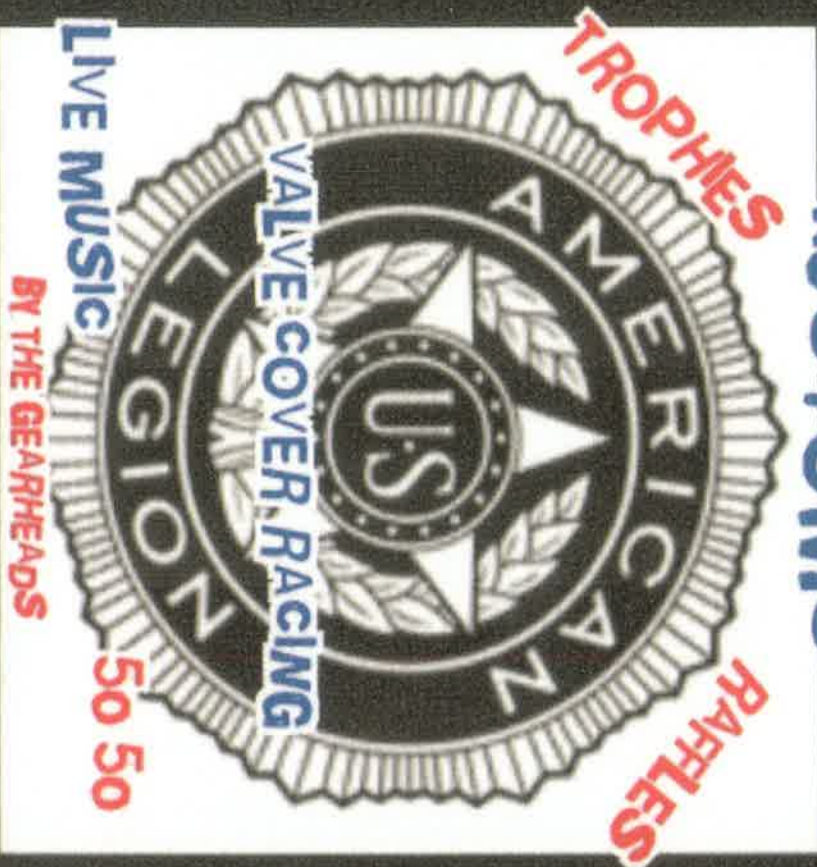

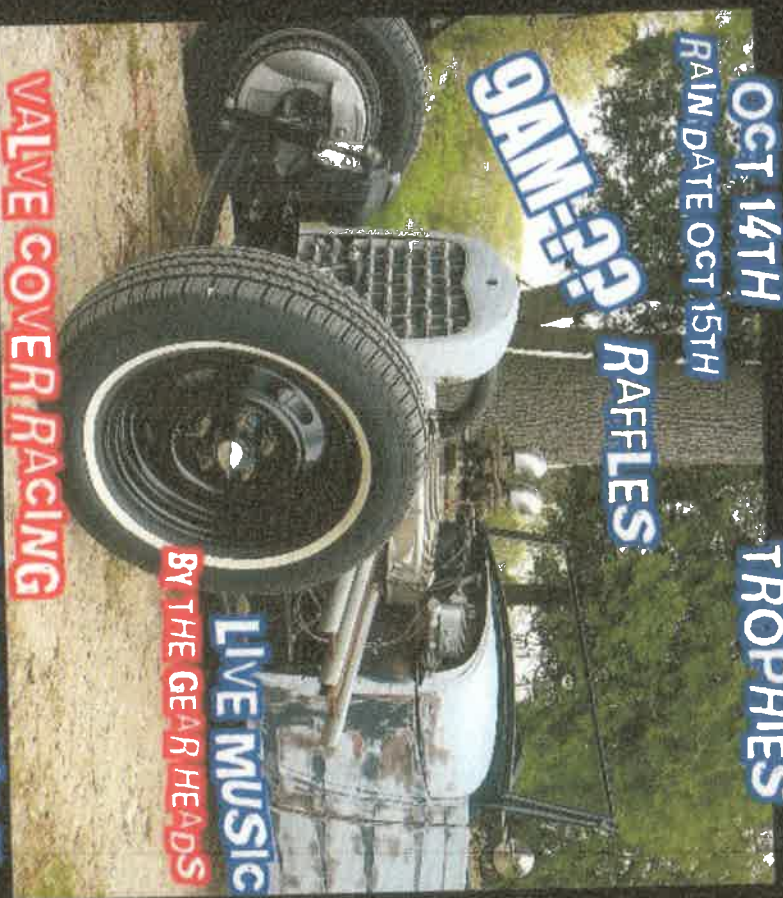
