The roof on our post is in a state of disrepair after we sustained inside damage and after an inspection of our post's roof and it is because of natural wear and our insurance provider will not cover the replacement cost, which is \$8,500.00 and this is an amount too great for us to be able to pay and replace the roof ourselves.

I am asking you, Sir, as a fellow comrade and District Commander to reach out to all your posts and see if they can contribute in any way to our dire need for funds to replace our roof. I know that money is extremely tight and that some may not be able to donate, and I understand that completely, being in that position ourselves.

I have attached several photos of the inside damage and the areas of the roof from the outside that are covered to reduce further inside damage until we can afford to have the roof replaced.

We are fortunate in one respect that there is only one layer of roofing shingles on the building now and that greatly reduced the cost of replacement.

So, Sir, once again, I ask that you reach out to all your posts in your district and see if they can help in any way monetarily and whatever they can afford, no matter the amount, would be greatly appreciated.

God Bless you all for the fine job you all do within your districts and in the state and nation., Without all of you, it would be so very hard for all of us to accomplish the tasks put before us.

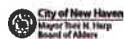
