My Fellow Legionnaires:

Last week it was an honor to watch our new National Commander, Denise Rohan, take the oath of office at The American Legion National Convention in Reno NV. It was not such a pleasure to hear that our Legion membership had indeed dropped below 2M members for the first time in our history! Just speaking for the Dept. of CT, we had our membership goal reduced by 1,000 members for 2016-17. In spite of this reduced goal we still came up approximately 1,300 members short. Our goal for 2017-18 now remains the same as 2016-17 (19,800). We certainly have our work cut out for us and here's how we can do it.

First, every post should be signed onto MyLegion.org. We have enhanced capabilities this year at every level; post, district, and department. MyLegion is a vital membership tool and we need the all the tools at our disposal to do the job. Second, we need to attract new members. That's NEVER news. Third, we had far too many active members who failed to renew their membership for 2017. Why? Did they pass onto Post Everlasting and we didn't know? Were they incapacitated and we didn't know? Were they in financial difficulty and we didn't know? Did we do something wrong in their eyes and we didn't know? Well, until we personally contact these members and ask, we'll never know. In addition to attracting new members and renewing our current numbers, we must personally contact those who didn't renew for 2017 and bring them back into the fold. That's some work, but it must be done. If we have to knock on doors, then we knock. Personal contact says we care and we're concerned. We must start NOW!

If District Commanders wish to conduct District Revitalizations, please let me or Department know. When you pick your dates I will arrange with National for the listings and I will be there to assist. District Revitalizations must be accomplished NLT Feb 2018. District Commanders need to identify the dates for revitalizations; the zip codes of their post locations and surroundings, the host post and also insure we have sufficient post manpower to get the job done. However, all posts need to start NOW in contacting expired members for every post!

100 years ago, our Connecticut Doughboys were fighting alongside other soldiers (French, English & many others), who were fighting against the Germans in the World War. The United States entered the war on April 6, 1917 and the war ended on Nov. 11, 1918. Prior to the close of the war, many comrades in arms and at home believed that there should be an organization to continue the comradeships that had been made on the front, in the trenches and at home. The American Legion was formed from those men and women. March 15-17 (1919) annually is the American Legion, National Organization Birthday. A National Executive committee was formed and they issued to each state a charter, May 23, 1919. Connecticut, informally organized, but it wasn't until June 10, 1919 that motions were made and accepted to have an American Legion Branch in Connecticut.

100 years... Even today, we need to remember those men and women who died for us and made the ultimate sacrifice. We named our posts after many of those veterans, who were the first to die. I hope that you will make a special effort to recognize those veterans and your post founding fathers in the coming months.

1919 June 10: First Temporary Executive Committee agrees to incorporate a Connecticut American Legion at the City Club in Hartford.

1920 February: Rehabilitation Commission is initiated by State Adjutant Thomas J. Bannigan (afterward manager of the Veteran Bureau, now known as the VA). American Legion Auxiliary gets involved.

1940 Oratorical program initiated in Connecticut. Chaired by Dept. Sr. Vice John R. Feegel. Department Winner was from the 3rd District: Nelson D. Willis

1942 103 boys attend 1st Boys' State held at UCONN at \$18 per student. Dept Commander was Arthur J. Connell & the chairman was Carlos E. Ellis.

1950 The old YMCA Camp in Durham was offered to the Legion for \$30,000.

1956 1st American Legion College held at Camp Ribicoff, June 1-3 at a cost of \$10.00

1961 The first V-J Day Parade is held in Moosup. Ever since, it has been held on the second Sunday in August at 1 p.m.

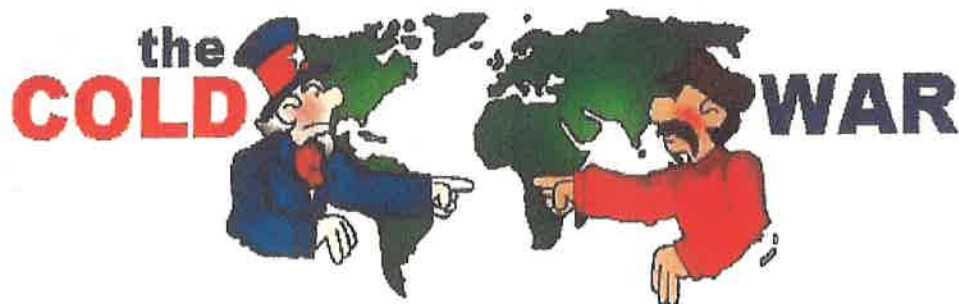
